

Information and Equipment list for Key Stage 2 (Years 3 -6)

General Information

In KS2 children line up with their class in the playground when the bell is rung at 8.45am. The class teacher collects the class from the playground. If your child is late they must come to the school office to register. The doors to the playground are locked after the classes have entered.

At the end of the school day children can be collected from 3.15pm. Please arrange with your child where on the KS2 or KS1 playgrounds they will be met. If a child has not been collected by 3.25pm they must go to the office.

Equipment List

Children will need the following:

- School uniform (see overleaf for details)
- P.E. kit in a named bag (see overleaf for details)
Please ensure their P.E. kit is left in school from Monday to Friday. P.E. is a requirement of the National Curriculum and it is very important children bring the appropriate kit. If your child cannot take part in a P.E. lesson please send a written explanation to the class teacher. Without a note children will be expected to take part in the lesson.
- A named transparent water bottle filled with fresh water each day. Drinking plenty of water aids children's learning.

- Costume (for boys this must be trunks not shorts, for girls this must be one piece)
- Towel
- Swimming hat (available from the school office)

- Making sure children have the correct equipment in school each day.
- Leaving jewellery at home (except watches).
- Making sure children wear waterproof coats or sunhats.
- Making sure all clothes and shoes are named
