Uniform and Equipment List for Key Stage 1 (Years 1 - 2)

General Information

Classes start at 8.45 am, finish at 3.15 pm.

The children stand in their class line in the mornings and the class teacher will come out to collect the class. This is an opportunity for any messages or letters to be passed on. The doors to the playgrounds are locked after all the classes have entered. If your child is late they must come to the school office to register. At the end of the day the children will be sent out through the door closest to their classrooms to the adult collecting them.

Equipment List

Children will need the following:

- School uniform see overleaf for details
- P.E. kit in a named bag see overleaf for details
 P.E. kit is left in school from Monday to Friday. P.E. is a requirement of the National Curriculum and it is very important children bring the appropriate kit. If your child cannot take part in a P.E. lesson please send a written explanation to the class teacher. Without a note children will be expected to take part in the lesson.
- A coat (preferably water resistant with a hood), gloves and warm hat
- Book bag (available from the school office)
- Water bottle, transparent and freshly filled each day
- Sun hat (and sunscreen applied before school)
- The children in KS1 attend Forest School regularly to explore the wooded area and the natural world. They need to have a pair of wellies in school all year round. During cold weather warm and waterproof clothing will also be required. Parents will be informed which days their class is doing Forest School.
- Swimming Summer Term only
 - Costume (for boys this must be trunks <u>not</u> shorts, for girls this must be one piece)
 - Towel
 - Swimming hat (available from the school office)

You can help us and your child by:

- Ensuring your child arrives punctually for school and attends regularly.
- Making sure children have the correct equipment in school each day.
- Making sure <u>all</u> clothes and shoes are named.
- Leaving jewellery at home (except watches and small stud earrings).
- Ensuring long hair is tied back.
- Apply sunscreen before school on hot days and send in a sunhat and sun-cream.

Snack We provide the children with a healthy snack each day (fruit or vegetable). Please provide a named transparent water bottle filled with fresh plain water each day. Drinking plenty of water aids children's learning.

School Lunches are free for children in Years 1 and 2. You may provide a healthy packed lunch from home if you wish.

The school uniform is:

- Burgundy sweatshirt or cardigan.
- Plain white collared shirt or white polo shirt.
- Navy blue, black or dark grey trousers or skirt, pinafore dress or shorts.
- Blue or red checked dress (optional).
- Sensible footwear, blue or black (no heels of more than 2.5 cm).
- Translucent waterbottle.

For PE from Year 1 upwards:

- T-shirt in burgundy OR your house colour
- Navy or black shorts or leggings (not baggy or ¾ length)
- Plain navy or black fleece/jumper and jogging bottoms for outdoor PE.
- Plimsolls or trainers
- Bag to keep your PE kit in
