

## Information and Equipment list for Key Stage 2 (Years 3 -6)

### General Information

In KS2 the children stand in their designated class line in the mornings ready to go in. The class teacher will come out to collect the class.

If your child is late they must come to the school office to register. The doors to the playgrounds are locked after all the classes have entered.

At the end of the day the children will be sent out through the door closest to their classrooms to the adult collecting them.

### Equipment List

Children will need the following:

- School uniform
- P.E. kit in a named bag  
**Please ensure their P.E. kit is left in school from Monday to Friday.** P.E. is a requirement of the National Curriculum and it is very important children bring the appropriate kit. If your child cannot take part in a P.E. lesson please send a written explanation to the class teacher. Without a note children will be expected to take part in the lesson.
- A named transparent water bottle filled with fresh water each day. Drinking plenty of water aids children's learning.

#### Swimming

Yr3/4 – Spring Term

- Costume (for boys this must be trunks not shorts, for girls this must be one piece)
- Towel
- Swimming hat (available from the school office)

**School lunches cost £2.30**

**Break time snacks** – children may bring a fruit or vegetable snack to school

### You can help us and your child by:

- Ensuring your child arrives punctually for school (the school bell rings at 8.45 a.m.).
- Ensuring children only bring fruit and vegetables for break time
- Making sure children have the correct equipment in school each day.
- Leaving jewellery at home (except watches).
- Making sure children bring waterproof coats every day.
- Making sure all clothes and shoes are named
- Apply sunscreen before school on hot days and send in a sunhat and sun-cream
- Ensuring long hair is tied back.
