

Uniform and Equipment for Key Stage 2 (Years 3 -6)

General Information

In KS2 the children are to be dropped off and collected on the KS2 playground. The gates open at 8.35 am, classes go in at 8.45 am. The doors to the playgrounds are locked after all the classes have entered. If your child is late they must come to the school office to register. Classes end at 3.15 pm.

Equipment List

Children will need the following:

- A named transparent water bottle filled with fresh water each day. Drinking plenty of water aids children's learning.
- School uniform – see overleaf for details
- P.E. kit in a named bag - see overleaf for details
Please ensure P.E. kit is left in school from Monday to Friday. P.E. is a requirement of the National Curriculum and it is very important children bring the appropriate kit. If your child cannot take part in a P.E. lesson please send a written explanation to the class teacher. Without a note children will be expected to take part in the lesson.
- Swimming Kit Yr 5/6 – Autumn Term, Yr 3/4 – Spring Term
 - Costume (for boys this must be trunks not shorts, for girls this must be one piece)
 - Towel
 - Swimming hat (available from the school office)

School lunches cost £2.40 per day from Year 3 upwards – please contact the office if you are on low income and think your child may be entitled to a free lunch.

Break time snacks – children may bring a fresh fruit or vegetable snack to school – please minimise packaging

You can help us and your child by:

- Ensuring your child arrives punctually for school and attends regularly.
- Making sure children have the correct equipment in school each day.
- Making sure children bring waterproof coats every day.
- Making sure all clothes and shoes are named.
- Leaving jewellery at home (except watches and small stud earrings).
- Ensuring long hair is tied back.
- Apply sunscreen before school on hot days and send in a sunhat and sun-cream.
- Ensuring children only bring fruit and vegetables for break time.

The school uniform is:

- Burgundy sweatshirt or cardigan.
- Plain white collared shirt or white polo shirt.
- Navy blue, black or dark grey trousers or skirt, pinafore dress or shorts.
- Blue or red checked dress (optional).
- Sensible footwear, blue or black (no heels of more than 2.5 cm).
- Translucent waterbottle.

For PE from Year 1 upwards:

- T-shirt in burgundy OR your house colour
- Navy or black shorts or leggings (not baggy or $\frac{3}{4}$ length)
- Plain navy or black fleece/jumper and jogging bottoms for outdoor PE.
- Plimsolls or trainers
- Bag to keep your PE kit in
