Scarlet Fever

Please be advised that we have had a case of Scarlet Fever in KS1. The symptoms include a sore throat, headache, fever and nausea. After 12-48 hrs, a fine red rash typically appears on the chest and stomach first. Scarlet Fever is common in children but much less common in adults. If you are at all concerned, pregnant or immuno-suppressed, please contact your GP.
