The School is not informed who has/has not provided consent until the nurses arrive on 5<sup>th</sup> December so it is your responsibility to submit your consent (or otherwise) **by 28<sup>th</sup> November 2019**. If you do not have access to the internet, please visit your local library to use their public internet. If you are unable to access the internet or need help with the online form, please come to the Office. The nurses will not vaccinate a child unless they have your online authority correctly completed.
