As mentioned before Easter, our Bike to School week is launching on Monday! We will be naming a winning class at the end of the week based on number of trips made on wheels and hope you keep up the good habit of 'wheeling' to school for the rest of the year. An anonymous donor has kindly pledged to donate £100 to our running track fundraiser on each day we reach the target of 20% of children coming to school on wheels. Travelling to school on wheels currently stands at 13% of children so let's all try to reach the target of 20% each day next week.

The children had a really interesting online Assembly this week from the Guinness World Record Holders for riding a tandem bicycle across the world. The Reception Classes are also holding their Wacky Wheels sponsored fundraiser on Tuesday 27th April but bring your wheels in every day if you can.
