Please consider these notes when parking.

- **The Highway Code states under rule 243:** "Do not park opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction, except in an authorised parking space"
- **Section 22 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 states:** "If a person in charge of a vehicle causes or permits the vehicle or a trailer drawn by it to remain at rest on a road in such a position or in such circumstances as to involve a danger of injury to other persons using the road, he is guilty of an offence"
- **Section 103 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 states:** "No person in charge of a motor vehicle or trailer shall cause or permit the vehicle to stand on a road so as to cause any unnecessary obstruction of the road"

If your vehicle is parked in breach of the above your details will be recorded, and you will receive either a £30 fixed penalty notice (sec 103) or £60 fixed penalty with 3 points (sec 22). Please be careful when parking.
