### Spring Flowers

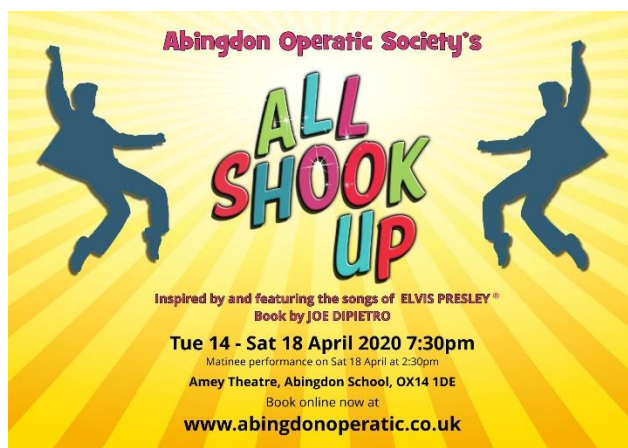
