Pupil Premium Grant

If your household is in receipt of Universal Credit, Income Support, the guarantee element of Pension Credit, Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 or others your child may be eligible for pupil premium which means you can get:

- ✓ Subsidised school trips for the whole of Primary school (including the Year 6 residential)
- ✓ Free class reading books
- ✓ Free school jumper every year
- ✓ Free school bag
- ✓ Free meals until at least March 2022
- ✓ Pastoral and curriculum support
- ✓ Free extra-curricular activities

The school receives £1,320 every year for each eligible child to help towards these costs. Please contact the Office to apply today!
