**Police Visit** - We had a visit this week from the police about illegal and obstructive parking on Bicester Road and Cromwell Way at pick up and drop off. We would again request that parents park considerately and within the law. Under no circumstances should anyone be double parking, stopping in the road or blocking driveways.

**Late Arrivals** - There have been a lot of children arriving late this week. This causes disruption to the other children in your child's class as teachers have to interrupt their routine and it also takes up the time of the Office staff who are very busy. Please arrive on the playground by 8.45am to ensure your child can line up with their classmates and start lessons on time.
