Primary School Admissions

If your child was born between 1/9/15 and 31/8/16, parents need to apply for a place in Reception Class at primary school for September 2020. You are now able to apply via the County Council admission portal. You should have received a letter from the Council with log in instructions. If you need any help with your application, please do come to the School Office and you need to make sure you have applied by the deadline of 15th January 2020. If you would like a tour of the school before applying, please contact the Office.

Flu Vaccinations (Nasal Spray) on 5th December

From this year, flu vaccinations are being offered to the whole school from Reception up to and including Year 6. Due to the numbers involved, the School Nurse Team are not providing paper consent forms this year. Please read your Parentmail message about how to give your consent online for your child’s flu vaccination. The School is not informed who has/has not provided consent until the nurses arrive on 5th December so it is your responsibility to submit your consent (or otherwise) by 28th November 2019. If you do not have access to the internet, please visit your local library to use their public internet. If you are unable to access the internet or do not understand the online form, please come to the Office. The nurses will not vaccinate a child unless they have your online authority correctly completed.
