**INSET Days** - We have 5 INSET Days per School Year. **House Points System** – You may see your child coming home wearing a '1 House Point' Sticker which is our new way of recognising children's efforts. The points will be recorded by the teacher and Bronze, Silver and Gold Certificates will be awarded upon reaching 25, 50 and 75 House Points. A Book Award will be awarded to any child who achieves 100 House Points this year.

KS2 children can purchase fruit/vegetable snacks at morning break time or they can bring in fruit or vegetable snacks from home.
