Social Distancing

We would like to thank everyone for your continuing co-operation. We are pleased with everyone's efforts since the start of term. However, in view of the increasing COVID-19 infection rates in the area, we would like to remind everybody of our social distancing measures. It would be appreciated if you could:

- Please arrive on site as close to your time slot as possible to reduce mixing between families – no earlier than 5 minutes before your first slot. We would request that nobody is on site before 8.30am. This also applies to children coming to school on their own.
- Please say goodbye to your child in Years 3-6 before they join the class queue in the morning. There should only be children in the line.
- Please avoid sitting on the benches on the playgrounds – these are for children's use only.
- The wooden play area on the KS1 playground is out of bounds.
- Please continue to follow the one-way system.
- We do expect all site users to maintain 2m social distancing between families and also when speaking to staff. You must keep your children with you at all times. Thank you.
- If you are late, please follow the one-way system and come to the Office.
- Please don't stop to chat so we can keep walkways clear.
- Please continue to form a double line for each class if needed so we can keep the walkways clear.
- Please do not park on the pavements anywhere around the school; it is illegal and also making life difficult for neighbours who are trying to socially distance on the pavement.

Thank you for taking note of the above so we can all keep safe.
