Edward Feild Primary School Accessibility Plan 2023-24

(Equality Act 2010 and Disability Discrimination Legislation 2005)

Individual adjustments already identified

a) Provide identified children with in-class and (if isolating) home learning access to ICT equipment	ipads and laptops for class use Chromebooks from government for home use, support with connecting for families at home.
b) Evacuation of hearing impaired staff/children	Fire alarm includes flashing lights
c) Long term medical/hearing	Support re medication and catch-up teaching, nurture room/audit of classroom, 1:1 support, support from Hearing Service – provision of teaching aids
d) Temporary user of crutches/wheelchair	Support for movement around the school, nurture room, personal emergency evacuation plans (PEEP)
e) SEND evacuation	Individual children who may react to fire alarm - personal emergency evacuation plans (PEEP)
f) Provide identified children with resources to support them to work in class	e.g. ear defenders, relaxation bands, balls, seat wedges, chewable toys, visual timetables.
g) Safe space for children with sensory needs	Sensory room and individual work areas in place.

Accessibility plan 23-24:

The following areas were identified as the next priorities for the school:

a) Safety of wheelchair users and younger children	Install lower vision panels in all doors	Ongoing as doors require replacement: all new doors to have this
b) Signage	Conduct survey of signage to identify any improvements	Summer 24
c) Tonal contrast	Conduct survey to identify any improvements required	Summer 24
