WALT: Write sentences including correctly-punctuated parenthesis.

As you know, parenthesis is a word or a phrase put into a sentence to give it more information. It can:

- Explain what a difficult word means.
- Show someone's thoughts.
- Add extra information to help the reader.
- Emphasise a point.

We use commas, dashes or brackets to punctuate parenthesis.

Using the picture below as a stimulus, write at least five sentences which include parenthesis e.g. *The ball - gleaming brightly and warmly - flew across the cloudless sky.*
