Dear Parents and Carers

We are looking forward to seeing you all again next week.

We sent you a ParentMail with a lot of information last week, so please check that if you need to know times for coming and going, what you need to bring to school, etc. There is a link to it here: <http://www.efs.oxon.sch.uk>

Staff will be outside on the first few days to help you find your way around – please note that if you have a gap between drop off for different classes you should drop off your first child then head straightaway to the queue for the next class. Please stay in class lines and keep a 2m distance from the next family.

Please can we remind everyone that it is extremely important that no adults or children come onto the school site if they have any symptoms of Covid-19: a high temperature, a new continuous cough or a loss of or change to their sense of taste or smell. If your child has even mild symptoms in the morning please keep them at home and monitor for a while – we will be sending children home where necessary and your family may have to self isolate for 14 days or until you get a negative test result.

Walking home permission

Children in Years 5 and 6 can walk home on their own with parents’ permission. A separate Parentmail will be sent out on Tuesday to sign up to this.

Bookbags

Reception families wishing to purchase a bookbag can pick one up on Friday 4th when they visit, or by emailing the office to fix a time to collect.
