



## Flight Year 1 and 2

### English

This term, we will be writing to inform by writing instructions on how to make a paper aeroplane, using imperative verbs. We will also be writing a letter from Amelia Earhart to apply to be a pilot, and will finish the term with an adventure story based on our texts.

Our Whole Class Reading texts this term will be Amelia Earhart and Rosie Revere Engineer.

### Maths

Children will be focusing on multiplication and division, shape and measurement, as well as continuing with their addition and subtraction knowledge from Autumn term. Our 'On the Boil' key number facts for the term will be to double and half numbers for Year 1, and to know division facts for x2, 5 and 10 for Year 2.

### History

Our History will be focusing around the question 'How did the first flight change the world?' Children will be retelling the story of the first flight, investigating early aeroplanes and making old and new aeroplanes, as well as finding out about their importance and how flight has changed the world.

### Science

In Science, children will be learning about their environment as well as animals and their needs.

### Art/Design and Technology

Children will be creating their own kites.

### PSHE

Our sessions will focus on our school value of Creativity.

### Computing

We will be focusing on programming toys.

### P.E.

This term, children will be focusing on agility, balance and coordination in their PE lessons.

### R.E.

The children will be learning about and understanding celebrations from different religions.

### Music

In music, children will be learning about rhythm and pulse through singing and percussion instruments.
