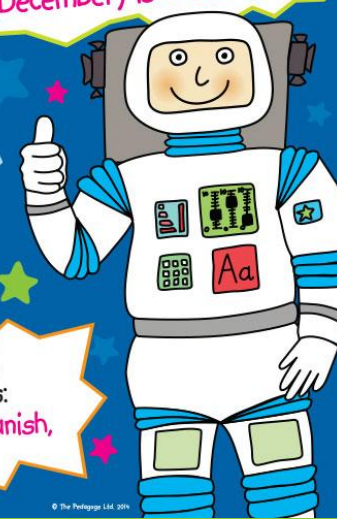
When using 'I':

Where is my racing car?



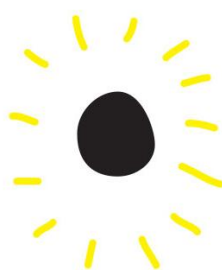
